### **ACADEMIC PROGRAMS:**

### **Internal Benchmark Assessments:**

Students in grades 2<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade completed beginning of year internal benchmark assessments using EasyCBM for English Language Arts and Math in September. Grades 2<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> will complete another set of assessments and 1<sup>st</sup> grade will complete the first assessment in mid January as one method of tracking student progress. For the fall parent-teacher conferences, teachers used the results of these assessments combined with results on teacher made assessments and observations to share an overall picture of each child's academic, social, and emotional growth. The internal assessment results combined with teacher made assessments and standardized test scores are also used to determine which students need academic intervention support. Our intervention teachers target specific skills such as decoding/phonics, reading fluency, reading comprehension, math fluency, and math concepts based on students' needs.
