

## Element 12 – Public School Attendance Alternatives

*“The public school attendance alternatives for pupils residing within the school district who choose not to attend charter schools.” (Ed. Code § 47605(b)(5)(L).)*

Pupils of Charter School do not have or gain any right to admission in a particular school of any school district, or program of any school district, as a consequence of applying to or enrolling in Charter School, except to the extent that such a right is extended by the school district.

A pupil who chooses not to attend Charter School may attend a public school within the pupil’s school district of residence in accordance with applicable law and that school district’s policies and procedures. The pupil alternatively may seek to enroll in another charter school in accordance with applicable law and the terms of the school’s charter. If LAUSD is the pupil’s school district of residence, an eligible pupil may pursue an inter-district transfer, if available, in accordance with the admission, enrollment, and transfer policies and procedures of the District, as they may change from time to time.

### Public School Attendance Alternatives

Ocean Charter School is a school of choice. Pupils who choose not to attend Ocean Charter School may choose to attend other public schools in their district of residence or pursue an interdistrict-transfer in accordance with existing enrollment and transfer policies of the District.

The governing board of a school district shall not require any pupil enrolled in the school district to attend a charter school.

Ocean Charter School confirms that the parent(s) or guardian(s) of each pupil enrolled in the charter school shall be informed in the enrollment packet that the pupil has no right to admission in a non-charter District school (or program within a District school) as a consequence of enrollment in the charter school, except to the extent that such a right is extended by the District.
