# **Annual District Review and Oversight Visit**

The LAUSD team from the Charter Schools Division (CSD) spent the day meeting with OCS Administrators, visiting classrooms, conducting the fiscal review, and reviewing the new electronic binders at the Del Rey campus on Friday, January 25<sup>th</sup>. Some of the key areas of focus observed in the classrooms were use of cooperative movement activities to build class culture and the use of collaborative learning strategies. The team was impressed by the life sized heart formation of Kindergarten children observed from the upstairs balcony, the first grade step-by step instruction of a main lesson book drawing, the multiplication songs and movement demonstration in second grade, and the collaborative shelter project groups in the third grade!

The CSD team will return on Friday, February  $8^{th}$  to visit the Westchester campus and observe the  $4^{th} - 8^{th}$  grade students. The key areas of focus include the use of rubrics in student self-evaluation and teacher evaluation, as well as collaborative learning strategies and cooperative movement to build class culture.

#### **ACADEMIC PROGRAMS:**

### Standardized Testing:

#### **ELPAC**

English Language learners in grades TK – 8<sup>th</sup> will be assessed in English language proficiency using the ELPAC assessment this year in April.

#### **CAASPP**

Students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> will participate in the CA standardized assessment in May. While addressing the Common Core standards throughout the year, specific preparation for the testing began when students returned from the winter break. Preparation includes taking practice tests on the CAASPP website, learning testing strategies, building typing skills, practicing relaxation and concentration, and reviewing key concepts and skills in ELA (English Language Arts) and Math.



## **Internal Benchmark Testing:**

## **EasyCBM**

Students in grades 1<sup>st</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> participate in the EasyCBM (Curriculum Based Measurement) benchmark assessments multiple times during the school year to measure growth in the common core standards. The internal assessments help inform instruction in the classroom and assist teachers in referring students to Intervention.

# Kindergarten Assessment

Transitional Kindergarteners and Kindergarteners participate in internal benchmark assessments in the fall and spring each year. The assessments measure growth in common core standards integrated with developmental milestones and Waldorf standards. The internal Kindergarten assessments help inform instruction and assist teachers in determining whether a student would benefit from the gift of more time in Kindergarten.
