## **Del Rey Campus Update:**

### Marina Christian Fellowship Lease Agreement

An extension of the existing lease agreement was executed by MCF and OCS on May 2<sup>nd</sup> and includes a 5% increase to the rent.

### **Emergency Systems and Emergency Supplies**

The Emergency Fire Alarm System on campus will be serviced this week as a result of the alarm going off unexpectedly in the late evening last Tuesday. Fire extinguishers will be serviced as well, as they are typically serviced annually during the summer.

### Summer Activities on Campus

The campus will be buzzing with activity this summer with children attending Red Rose Camp, KITE classes, and an early childhood education program.

### Summer Cleaning and Moving Classrooms

This summer, instead of purchasing moving boxes to pack up classroom materials, we are renting recycled storage boxes. The recycled boxes are environmentally friendly and are more cost effective than purchased ones.

The usual deep cleaning, including carpets, floors, cupboards, etc. will make the DR campus shine when the students and teachers return to school in August.
