Joint Dr. Martin Luther King Assembly:

OCS and WESM hosted a joint assembly in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. on February 16th. The assembly featured performances by students as well as a performance by Mr. Gerald Rivers, OCS percussion teacher and the voice of Dr. King.



Fourth-Eighth grade students and a few parents learned the backstory of Black History Month and received the gift of Mr. Gerald Rivers' performance of two of Dr. King's speeches. A noted scholar on the words and works of Dr. King, Mr. Rivers considers it his life's work to bring these truth filled reminders to audiences all over the US and internationally. Dr. King had a lot more to say than 'I Have A Dream'. He was a true visionary and his words are as relevant to us today as they were when he first spoke them over 50 years ago. Faculty Professional Development:

The faculty participated in a full day of Professional Development on Friday, March 5th. All K-8th grade teachers participated in Breakout Sessions by grade, including Writing Curriculum, Leveled Reading Curriculum, the Singing Curriculum through the grades with Joan Newton, Singing practice for the Beach Clean-A-Thon with Stephanie McGurk, and a Movement Presentation and Activity with Annette Parry.

OCS Resource teachers were provided a Special Education refresher course with Case Manager, De'Andra Montgomery. The agenda included: Writing Notifications and Deadlines, Writing IEP's, Present Levels, Informal Assessments, Phonics and Decoding Lessons, How to hold small groups, Incorporating Sight words into Lessons, Demonstrations, Emails, Headings for Emails, Keeping email trails organized, DVR, Importance of Providing Services, and Consistency in Providing Services.

During the morning Professional Development, OCS Games Teachers received specialized Games training at Environmental Charter School with Annette Parry. In the afternoon, all faculty, including class teachers, resource teachers, and games teachers participated in Games Activities with Annette Parry, OCS Games Mentor.
