Deferral Exemption Request Narrative

As indicated in the attached cash flow projection (Attachment #2), Ocean Charter will not be able to meet its financial obligations in the Fall of 2021 if it is subject to the deferral of the February through June state payments. In order to manage the deferrals, Ocean will draw the remaining \$850K on its \$1.3M line of credit in March 2020. Even with this draw-down, Ocean will have just \$279K in cash as of June 30, 2020, which is under the recommended 5% cash reserve. Per the terms and covenants stipulated on the line of credit, Ocean must pay down its line of credit to zero in October 2021 and have a 30 day resting period with a zero balance. As a result, Ocean will run out of cash in October 2021. Having exhausted all sources of borrowing, Ocean Charter respectfully requests exemption from the February through June payment deferral in order to meet its financial obligations in Fall 2021.
