
Suspension and Expulsion Tiered Intervention Plan

By using data analysis, targeted tiered intervention, and the Discipline Foundation Policy, as well as technical support for special education students provided by Special Education Charter Operated Programs, the Charter Schools Division strives to ensure that LAUSD authorized Charter Schools will:

1. Maintain a school-wide suspension rate under 5%
2. Reduce suspension event disproportionality rates of student subgroups (e.g. Students with Disabilities and/or African American students) to not reach or exceed 15% at any time
3. Reduce non-mandatory suspensions as defined by the school's charter

LEVELS OF INTERVENTION*



The severity of the issue will determine the level at which the intervention begins. If the issue is not fully and adequately resolved within the established timeline, the intervention will proceed to the next level. ***A written response from the Charter School detailing the proposed remedy is expected at each level of intervention.**
