1. Call 911 and/or other emergency number consistent with organizational policies.
CA Poison Control: 1-800-222-1222

2. Instruct emergency medical services (EMS) personnel to
“Report to OCEAN CHARTER SCHOOL, 12870 Panama St., Los Angeles, CA 90066
and meet Staff at Curb/Gate (1st Choice) Front desk (2nd Choice) Gym (3rd Choice) as we have
an injured student-athlete in need of emergency medical treatment.”

3. Provide necessary information to EMS personnel:
 - Name and telephone number of caller (Main School # is 310-827-5511)
 - Number of victims: condition of victim(s)
 - Identify injury (head/neck, fracture, loss of consciousness, heat illness, cardiac arrest, etc.)
 - First-aid treatment initiated
 - Specific directions as needed to locate scene (SEND ADULT TO MEET EMT’s at Front Gate)
 - Other information as requested by dispatcher

4. OCS Staff (or Adult Volunteer if no staff present) will provide appropriate emergency care until arrival of EMS personnel: on arrival of EMS personnel, the Staff/Adult Volunteer will provide pertinent information (method of injury, vital signs, treatment rendered, medical history) and assist with emergency care as needed.
Note:
 - Contact Parents of student ASAP after 911 to inform, and get verbal consent if transport needed.
 - Obtain student emergency card and insurance information card

Gym: Abridged allergen and family info in Red First Aid Backpacks
 - Adult Volunteer (If Parent not present) should accompany student-athlete to the hospital

Pre-season coaches meeting

- Discuss the need to inspect and recondition equipment.
- Review OCS Coach Pledge, NAYS/FIYA Training(s), OCS Training(s)
- Review game management procedures
- Review emergency plan
 - Include coaches' responsibilities in the event of medical emergency

Prior to events

- Charge cell phone
- Identify students with injuries or health problems
- Check for adequate medical supplies
 - AED in Gym
 - Transport equipment (wheel chair, crutches) in Nurse's Station
 - Ice, towels, Ziploc bags in Nurse's Station
 - OCS Athletics First Aid Backpacks
 - 2: One for Athletics Dept. Closet and One stored in closet, but taken to away games
 - Emergency contact and allergen list
 - Emergency procedures and protocols (SERT and EAP)
 - General First Aid Supplies: bandaids, gauze, tape, alcohol pads, burn cream, sanitizer, ace bandage, triangle bandage
 - Tools: scissors, mouthguard, whistle, flashlight, mask
